“Green Waste Disposal Day” is an event established to provide City of Sonora residents an opportunity to clear their property of hazardous vegetation and dispose of it at the Cal Sierra Earth Resource Facility for a nominal fee. This program aids residents in creating an important “*fire safe defensible space*,” while improving the aesthetics of the City’s neighborhoods, at the significantly reduced disposal rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per cubic yard.

The **Cal Sierra Earth Resource Facility, at 14909 Camage Avenue (off Tuolumne Road)**, will accept vegetation from Sonora City residents presenting a coupon on **Saturday, April 9, 2022** and **Saturday, April 16, 2022**, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m..

ATTACHED ARE THREE (3) DISCOUNT DISPOSAL COUPONS. Resident participants will be required to provide identification verifying they live within the City limits along with a Green Waste Disposal Day Discount Coupon with their name and address printed clearly on the back of the certificate. The cost is \$1.00 per qualified vehicle with less than one (1) cubic yard, of debris. Commercial customers must pay the regular rate.

ACCEPTABLE items include:



YES!

- Grass clippings, leaves
- Pine needles, flowers
- Tree trimmings, brush.
- Dead plants

NO!

- Waste, liquids, trash, ashes or plastic bags
- Plastic, glass, metal or wire items
- Pet waste or kitty litter
- Tree stumps
- Palm Trees

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

This program is an annual event that allows City residents to dispose of their green waste at a significantly reduced rate, while providing the perfect opportunity to reduce green waste fuels (brush, weeds, limbs, and grass) that contribute to urban wildland fire hazards. The threat of fire is a stark reality our City faces every fire season. The City of Sonora Fire Department encourages City residents to participate in this program to create defensible space around their homes and outbuildings by removing flammable vegetation.
